CDSF (HSPS) OPEN COMPETITION

Youth and Senior couples can participate in Adult age categories.

DSE GRAND PRIX

For Juvenile II Open WDSF Syllabus must be applied.

LA (SB, CCC, RB, JV) (basic only)

CDSF (HSPS) RANKING COMPETITION

Couples can participate only in one class & age category in Standard & Latin.

For all age categories D1, D2, D3, C WDSF syllabus must be applied.

VALID REGULATIONS FOR SOLO

WDSF SOLO OPEN FEMALE

An athlete can compete in her age category and also in the first higher age category according to the WDSF rules.

For Solo Juvenile II Open (5 dances) WDSF Syllabus must be applied.

CDSF (HSPS) NATIONAL SOLO RANKING COMPETITION

An athlete can participate only in one class & age category in Standard & Latin.

For all age categories D1, D2, D3, C WDSF syllabus must be applied.

VALID REGULATIONS FOR CHOREOGRAPHIC TEAMS

Teams must perform routines that provide minimum three choreographed separation of the team members into modules.

Through routine team members regroup together and then proceed with a next choreographed separation into further modules.

In routine, members of the team can create form of couple, but not for more than 10% of the total duration of routine.

- Small team: 4 to 12 athletes: male, female or mixed.
- Big team: 13 to 24 athletes: male, female or mixed.

Small and Big teams compete together.

Each team may include athletes who belong to an adjacent older age category or categories as follows:

- Teams up 4 to 7 members 2 athlete can be older
- Teams 8 to 12 members 3 athletes can be older
- Teams 13 to 20 members 4 athletes can be older
- Teams 21 to 24 members 5 Oathletes can be older

No limitation in number of younger athletes if the number is lower than 51%.

WDSF Age Groups apply.

WDSF Dress regulations apply, it's allowed to use costumes from one older age group (Juvenile II can use Junior I costumes, Junior I can use Junior II etc.).

Members of team must have same design of costume, but color can be different. All team members must be on the dance floor from the beginning to the very end.

The team provides its own music. The music must be uploaded in the MP3 format. Duration of the music is 2:00 to 4:00 minutes.

It is not allowed to combine Standard and Latin dances. Routine must include all 5 dances of the selected discipline, except Juvenile I who can use just 3 dances (SB, CCC, JV).

Props are not allowed. During the performance no athlete may throw or place on the floor, even temporarily, objects or accessories, even if these are parts of his/her costume.

Persons other than members of the team shall not enter the competition floor and scenic elements may not be placed on the floor.

At the end of the performance the team must leave the floor completely clear and clean.

The team has 15 seconds to either enter or leave the dance floor.

Participating clubs are not allowed to use same routine or the same soundtrack for more than once on the same competition.
